Three new Rugby Fives Courts were opened recently at St. Dunstan's College, Catford, by the present Headmaster, Mr. Usherwood. The courts together with one Eton Fives court were erected as a memorial to the late Headmaster, Mr. C. M. Stuart. After the ceremony a team representing the Rugby Fives Association played a match against the Old Dunstonions, the courts being pronounced perfect.
