NOTE:

1. Entries will be accepted by posted mail accompanied by the entry form and a cheque made payable to the Organiser, D.E.Gardner, and sent to 5 Andace Park Gardens, Widmore Road, Bromley, Kent, BR1 3DH.
2. An e-mail entry will be accepted with an electronic bank transfer, should anyone wish to enter by this method. Bank details will be given to Team Captains on request to the Organiser. Money transfer should be sent at the same time as the e-mail. Entries will not be taken as 'confirmed' until the bank transfer has arrived!
3. Entry fees are non-refundable in the event of the withdrawal of a player. However a reserve may be substituted with the permission of the Organiser. Once the draw has been made (Monday 3rd November), any such alterations to pairs in the Doubles will only be accepted in exceptional circumstances. The positional placement in the draw of such a pair will be at the discretion of the Organisers.
4. All four Finals (Singles, Doubles, Singles Plate and Doubles Plate) will be played on the Sunday morning. This schedule will not be altered. All players should note this before they decide to enter, and be available to play when required.
5. Grants to Teams/Individuals. Under the old BUCS system, many teams received assistance towards transport/accommodation etc. from their Athletic Union. Should they find that the AU no longer assists with the new BUSF format or offers only limited support, they should contact the Organiser to discuss things, as the RFA may also be able to offer some support. This applies particularly to those Captains seeking to bring large team numbers (more than 4) or to those teams and individuals having to travel very long distances to the event.
6. In line with new Government rulings that FE (full- or part-time further education) should be continuous until 18, the BUSF events will return to their former format, with entries restricted to HE (Higher Education) students only (Universities and equivalent Institutions). This comes into immediate effect for 2014.
