There will be Plate competitions for those eliminated in the early rounds each day. The tournament will be organised to give everyone, regardless of ability, a good weekend of Fives.

Qualifying age is 45 years on or before 1st April 2017. Entry fees are £12.00 for the Singles and £24.00 per pair for the Doubles. Players interested in taking part in the Doubles, but lacking a partner, may submit their names and contact details. Every effort will be made to match them up with a compatible partner.
