## AMERICAN DOUBLES COMPETITION FORMAT

This type of competition is a good way to mix players of all abilities and have some fun. It also gives the lower ability player to stand a chance of winning.

## How do I set this Type of Competition up?

- Firstly, Rank the players according to ability. Then partner the players so that the top ranked player is partnered with the lowest ranked player, e.g. if there are 12 players, Number 1 being the top player and Number 12 being the lowest ranked, are partnered together.

Go down your list:
$1+12 ; 2+11 ; 3+10 ; 4+9 ; 5+8 ; 6+7$.

- Secondly, it is your choice on how you wish to organise the Competition at this point, with regards to a Round Robin format or a straight Knock-Out.

ROUND ROBIN ALTERNATIVE (With 12 Players):
(i) Split the Pairs into 2 Pools of 6 Pairs

- That means you have a Total of 15 games to play
- Games To Play Formula: 6 Pairs, that means $5+4+3+2+1=15$ Total Games.
- Time Formula? Allow approximately 20 minutes per game and short break: 15 x $20=5$ hours.
